Occidental moving from downtown Wichita to Northrock

Occidental Management will have a new home -- and more space -- when it moves into its Northrock business office complex this summer, chairman Gary Oborny says.

The real estate development company will be moving from its building on 300 N. Main to 29th and Rock Rd. in northeast Wichita in June or July, Oborny says. Occidental is turning the former Northrock 6 theater in an 80,000 square foot office complex, the naming rights of which have been secured by Corporate Lodging, which is occupying the entire third floor starting in late May.

Occidental will be on the main level and have approximately 4,000 square feet, Oborny says. It has outgrown the 3,000 square feet it currently has downtown.

"We love being downtown," Oborny says. "There's just kind of a camaraderie that comes with being a downtowner. But we need to expand, and we're obviously very excited about the new place."
